

POOL BLANKET INSTALLATION GUIDELINE

It is advisable to use two (2) people for the installation of your pool blanket and/or roller.

- Ensure that your pool is at the correct water level.
- Carefully place on the long edge of the pool.
- Unfold and **spread** the pool blanket over the surface of the pool with the **<u>bubble side facing</u>** <u>**downwards**</u>.
 - Sunlover highly recommend leaving the blanket in the sun for a couple of hours to give the cover time to 'relax', allowing any packing creases to settle.
 - Sunny days are the best for this procedure, however, it may take longer when the weather is overcast. Alternatively, you can push out the creases using a pool broom.
 - When your blanket has settled it is then ready to trim to size.
- Smooth the cover out, over the pool surface, getting rid of wrinkles and air pockets
- Using a pair of **<u>sharp</u>** household scissors cut the blanket to the shape of your pool.
- The blanket should be cut 2-5cm over the edge of your pool, so that it 'turns up' at the edges, creating a bowl effect within the pool.

ENSURE THE BLANKET DOES NOT MOVE WHILE CUTTING IT TO SIZE.

It is advisable to have someone hold the cover still, at the opposite side of the pool while trimming.

• Cut a small flap (just under the size of your skimmer box) in the pool blanket for your skimmer box, then fold into the skimmer box.

This will allow you to hose any debris into the skimmer box, keeping your pool clean and saving you money on unnecessary filter maintenance.

After 2-3 weeks if you feel there is too much material you can complete a small trim to the blanket ensuring the material still 'turns up' at the edges.

Once your cover is in place, it is important to check the settings on your automated chlorinator.

Your new pool cover will cut chemical usage by around half, so you need to make adjustments.

We recommend turning automatic chlorinators down to half the previous setting, then checking pool chemical levels and continuing to adjust settings daily until the appropriate levels are reached.

Cutting Guide

Sunlover recommends cutting your blanket to sit slightly proud of the water at each end to allow for expansion and contraction with the varying temperatures.
